Homework



- ▶ In general, given out on a Monday and due in on a Friday via the assignments tab on Teams.
- ▶ Marking of homework– feedback will be given on Teams weekly and jotters will be collected and reviewed termly at holidays.
- ▶ Should be spending about 30 minutes per evening on homework in line with school policy.
- ▶ Homework should never be a battle. It is revision of concepts covered in class.
- ▶ Pupils must take responsibility for their own homework.
 - Remembering to hand it in on time.
 - Completing to an appropriate standard.
 - Ensuring they ask **before** Friday if they need help.
- ▶ Examples of homework tasks: Spelling, Maths, Language, Reading, Topic and personal projects.
- ▶ Reading for enjoyment–encouraging personal reading at home.
 - Novels/annuals/comics/magazines etc. Anything your child wants to read counts as reading.
 - A recommended reading list will be uploaded onto Teams.

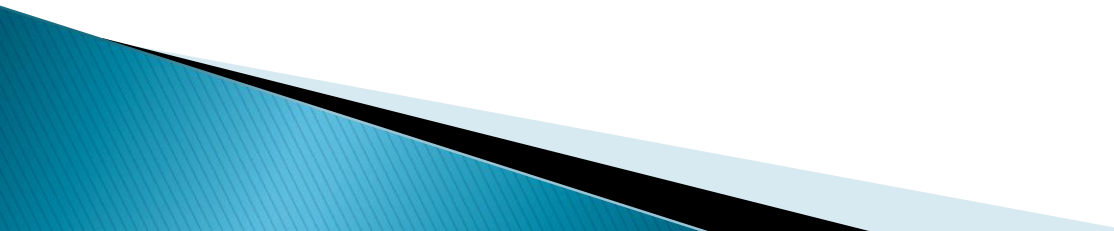


P.E – always outdoors
