



Termly Learning P1a – Term 2



In Numeracy and Maths:



- We will be developing and extending our knowledge of numbers to 20 (and beyond). Forwards and backwards counting, before, after and in between, ordering numerals, counting objects.....
- We will investigate odd and even numbers and the concepts of halving and sharing.
- We will be developing our knowledge of time by looking at the seasons, days of the week and months of the year.
- We will be investigating 3D objects.
- We will explore patterns and symmetry.
- We will begin to partition numbers and look at the concept of addition.

In Health and Wellbeing:

- We will continue to make independent choices and become more responsible as we play and complete our star tasks.
- We will be learning about firework safety.
- Star of the week- sharing compliments.

In PE: (on Tuesdays)

- We will explore safe use of space and spatial awareness.
- Team Games and ball skills



Digital Literacy

This term, we will be learning about computer science and the different parts of a computer and how to log on to a laptop and use the keyboard. We will also be continuing to practise our mouse skills.




In Literacy:

- We will be reading 'What's in the Witch's Kitchen?' by Nick Sharratt. We'll even write our own spooky story maps!
- We will have daily 'Jolly Phonics' practice where we learn how to say, write and blend sounds. We also learn Tricky Words which can't be sounded out.
- We will begin using our phonics and tricky words to read books in small groups in school – retelling the story and talking about the characters, setting, words, pictures and punctuation.
- We will practise how to write our letters using the correct formation.

In French:

- We will be learning basic classroom instructions, greetings and numbers to 10.
- We will explore French Christmas traditions.

Main Contexts for Learning

- **Expressive arts** – we will be developing our skills in the context of Christmas including dance, poetry reading, drama and music.
- **Families** – we will complete our work on families, caring for a baby and our personal history.
- **Autumn** – We will go outdoors to learn more about signs of Autumn.
- 'Remembrance Day'. 
- **RME** – Christmas story
- **Toys** – we will explore the history of toys and current toys. We will investigate how toys work – forces involved and electricity.
