



Termly Learning P2c – Term 2



Numeracy and Maths

- We will continue to revise number bonds up to 20 with a focus on rapid recall. We will explore different strategies for addition and subtraction and ways to record our work. We will be learning to recall doubles and near doubles within 20 and beyond.
- We will be learning to estimate the position of numbers within 100, and to estimate answers to our calculations.
- We will be learning about symmetrical patterns and shapes.
- We will be continuing to recognise and create our own number and shape sequences

- New grammar skills will be taught each week to help us with our reading and writing.
- In talking and listening, we will be focusing on listening to others in a respectful way and sharing information with detail, eye contact and appropriate voice.
