Homework:

- Two grids to be issued consecutively this term, each lasting 4 weeks.
- Each grid contains 12 activities covering a variety of curricular areas.

- Children will be given the opportunity every fortnight to share the learning from their activities by either bringing it into school or uploading on to Teams.
- Verbal feedback will be given at each fortnightly check-in.

In Literacy:

Grammar

Reading

- Class novel read aloud to whole class.
- Personal reading at home and in school (ERIC time).
- Novel Study: How to Train Your Dragon, The Amazing Story of Adolphus Tips, Hetty Feather or Iron Man.
- Continued use of cooperative reading skills.
- Non-fiction comprehension.
- Wordless Picture Book

Writing

- Poetry, focussing on rhyming and rhyming schemes.
- Newspaper article
- Continuing to develop the use of cursive handwriting and presenting our work neatly.

Talking and Listening

- Following increasingly complex instructions.
- Listening to and respecting our peers.
- Cooperative Reading
- Through Scotland topic
