In Numeracy and Maths:

- Numeracy develop and extend our knowledge of numbers to 30 (and beyond). Forwards and backwards counting, before, after and in between, ordering numerals and counting objects.

Main Contexts for Learning

- Interdisciplinary Learning we will be exploring the context of 'Under the Sea' and linking this to Sustainability.
- Expressive Arts developing our drama, dance and music skills using the content of the Nativity. In Art, we will be focusing on shade and tone.
- RME How babies are welcomed into different cultures and religions. We will also look at the Christmas story through our Nativity.
- **Science** exploring the change of seasons, autumn into winter. Exploring water and its different states.

Digital Literacy

This term, we will continue to learn how to log on to a laptop and use the keyboard and trackpad. We will also be learning about internet safety.



In Literacy:

- Daily 'Jolly Phonics' sounds input
- We will begin to learn our Common Words (words which appear most often in stories and some words that can't be sounded out).
- We will practise how to write letters using the correct formation.
- In writing, we will introduce capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in a sentence.
- We will even have a go at sounding out and writing some simple words on our own!
- We will continue to send home and practise reading books in class.



In Health and Wellbeing:

- We will be learning about firework safety.
- We will be taking part in Anti-Bullying Week.
- In RSHP our focus this term will be Pregnancy and Looking After a Baby and When I Feel Sad or Upset.
