Homework:

- Two grids to be issued consecutively this term, each lasting 4 weeks.
- Each grid contains 12 activities covering a variety of curricular areas.
- Expectation of two activities to be completed each week.
- Activities can be recorded in homework jotters, through creating a model/poster/artwork, taking photos or uploading on Teams.
- Children will be given the opportunity every fortnight to share the learning from their activities by either bringing it into school or uploading on to Teams.
- Verbal feedback will be given at each fortnightly check-in.
