## General Information:

- We live in a climate which can have all four seasons in one day. Please make sure your child has appropriate outdoor clothing for the prevailing conditions. We do try and get children outside as much as we can whatever the weather. A waterproof jacket is vital for school.
- Please be aware that you must fill in a form at the office if prescription medicine is required to be given to your child. Please also ensure children carry their inhaler with them at all times as well as having a spare in school.
- Every year we send tonnes of unnamed and unclaimed clothing and lunch items to the clothing bank or the bin. Please label **everything** with full name, or initial and full surname. The iron-on labels are good for some things; however a good sharpie can work well too. Please also encourage your child to take

responsibility for their clothing and possessions. This is a skill they need to be able to do in their learning and it starts with their belongings.

- It is East Dunbartonshire policy that children must remove earrings for PE. If your child has had their ears pierced recently they will miss PE until the earrings can come out.
- We are a health promoting school. An ideal snack for playtime is fruit or baked crisps and a drink of water. No fizzy drinks please. One item only to eat or children don't get a chance to run around.
- ➤ Headlice is a national issue and takes all of the community to combat it. Please check your child's head regularly and seek advice if any are detected. Schools no longer do checks or send out notification to a class if there has been an outbreak. We will send regular reminders.
